Location: East side of Indianapolis; bordered by 16th Street on the north, 10th Street on the south, Emerson Avenue on the east and Sherman Drive on the west.

History: The neighborhood was developed around the 1910s and 1920s during a spurt in Indianapolis growth. It is named for St. Therese, the Little Flower of Jesus Catholic Church. Initially, it was a mainly Irish-Catholic neighborhood, with close ties to the church.

Style of homes: Arts and Crafts, California Bungalow, Colonial and Tudor Revival.
